

Connecting Unlimited Websites to a Single Installation of iDevAffiliate

Using the marketing groups feature, you can connect unlimited website to your single installation of iDevAffiliate.

To do this, simply create yourself a new marketing group. We suggest giving it a name that relates to the website you're connecting. Uncheck the (Use Default Incoming Traffic Page) box and enter the full URL to the website you're connecting. Let's assume you have the following domains.

- joesbicycles.com
- joesrollerskates.com

If you want to connect both of these websites to iDevAffiliate, you can install iDevAffiliate into either one of these domains or even a 3rd domain such as joesaffiliates.com. Now create a marketing group for each website.

Now that we've created the groups, we need to upload marketing materials to each group. When affiliates login to get their marketing materials, the traffic they send will be routed according to the Alternate Incoming Traffic Page set for the marketing group they take the marketing materials from.

Marketing groups that don't have an Alternate Incoming Traffic Page defined will use the Default Incoming Traffic Page setting in your Site Configuration.

If you have a single point of checkout, you just need that shopping cart system integrated with iDevAffiliate. If each of the websites you're connecting has its own shopping cart, each cart will need integrated with iDevAffiliate.
